Key Outcomes from the TPM in Świdnik

The 2nd Transnational Project Meeting of the AVATAR-SEN Project took place in Świdnik, Poland, from 12th to 13th December 2024, hosted by Specjalny Ośrodek Szkolno-Wychowawczy w Świdniku. Representatives from partner organizations gathered to review the project's progress, discuss upcoming milestones, and strengthen the collaboration within the team.

WP2 – Literature Review and Guide Development

WP2 - Literature Review and Guide Development

The WP2 Guide, refined through pilot feedback, offers strategies for integrating avatar technology in SEN education, focusing on reading comprehension. It emphasizes avatar customization and includes interactive materials. The guide is available in five languages: English, Greek, Turkish, Spanish, and Polish.

WP3 - Avatar Development

In WP3, progress was made in customizing avatars for SEN students. The University of Cyprus shared updates, ensuring avatars provide a personalized learning experience. Plans for tutorial videos for educators were also discussed.

WP4 - Interactive Reading Materials

In WP4, partners are developing reading comprehension tasks aimed at improving outcomes for students with intellectual disabilities.



What's Next for the AVATAR-SEN Project?

- Testing the FrameVR Platform: In January 2025, partners will test the FrameVR platform to enhance avatar-based learning experiences.
- Development of New Reading Tasks: Partners will continue creating and testing new tasks to improve reading comprehension for SEN students
- Dissemination Activities: The project will continue to promote its results by organizing teacher meetings to share outcomes and best practices, as well as through updates on social media and websites.
